


#### What is Christian Nationalism?

- "[A] cultural framework—a collection of myths, traditions, symbols, narratives, and value systems—that idealizes and advocates a fusion of Christianity with American civic life"
- "[A] set of beliefs that the nation is of, by, and for Christians"
- A fusion of Christian and American identities

• The first European settlers were devout Christians who came to the United States for religious freedom.




• The Founders were men of deep faith who relied on their Christian principles when establishing the country.





• The expansion of the United States was God's design for spreading Christian values.



• The United States' commitment to its (God-inspired) principles have contributed to the US' wealth and power.



• When it has acted on its Christian principles, the US has been a beacon of freedom and good for the world.



Christian nationalism seeks the fusion of Christianity and the United States

- Governmental institutions and policies should reflect Christianity
- True Americans are Christians

#### **Christian** Nationalism

- Christian nationalism isn't a religious worldview. It's a political worldview.
- Religion is complicated (beliefs, behaviors, belonging)
- Other aspects of religion have different effects
  - Beliefs about religious pluralism
  - Religious service attendance


#### Christian **Nationalism**

- Nationalism: national superiority and dominance, ethno-religious chauvinism directed at both foreign nationals and internal religious and ethnic minorities
- Patriotism: positive feelings about and a sense of pride in one's country, involves an inclusive sense of national belonging

## Christian Nationalism as a Concept


- These ideas are not new; the name Christian nationalism is new
- Emerges in 2015 in sociology
- Public press, esp. after 2021
- Initial framing = negative












#### Christian Nationalism is Both Savior and Smear

- Whitehead and Perry (2020)
- (1) The federal government should declare the United States a Christian nation.
- (2) The federal government should advocate Christian values.
- (3) The federal government should allow prayer in schools.
- (4) The federal government should allow the display of religious symbols in public spaces.
- (5) The success of the US is part of God's plan.
- (6) The federal government should enforce strict separation of church and state. (reversed)

#### **PRRI**

- (1) The US government should declare America a Christian nation.
- (2) US laws should be based on Christian values.
- (3) If the US moves away from our Christian foundations, we will not have a country anymore.
- (4) Being Christian is an important part of being truly American.
- (5) God has called Christians to exercise dominion over all areas of American society.

The public is somewhat evenly divided





#### Christian nationalism is linked to religion.

• Christian nationalism is associated with conservative religious traditions.



• Christian nationalism in the religious landscape




Christian nationalism is correlated with religious behaviors.




Christian nationalism is also a political project.

FIGURE 8. Support for Christian Nationalism, by Party Affiliation and Candidate Favorability Percent who qualify as:





#### Historical and projected share of Americans who identify as Christian










Figure 1. Christian nation support. Figure 1 depicts the probability respondents give the highest level of support for the dependent variable. Levels of Black inclusion are set at the mean (avg.) and at 1 standard deviation above (high) and below (low) the mean.




## FIGURE 13. Anti-Immigrant Attitudes, among Christian Nationalism Adherents by Race Percent who:


FIGURE 10. Views of Religious Pluralism, by Christian Nationalist Groups





FIGURE 3. Support for Sexism Increases for More Feminine, Christian Nationalist Men. Source: March 2021 survey; see table A3 for model estimates. Controls include demographics, attendance, religious tradition, partisanship, and sexual orientation.





Figure 4. Christian nationalists believe people choose to be gay, by LGB identity, Baylor 2017. Note. This model controls for age, race, education, gender, attendance, and partisanship. See Table A3 for full results.



## Processing the Themes of CN

- Stereotypes and Knowing
- Stereotypes are linked to the –isms– racism, sexism, etc.
- Stereotypes
  - CN is often related to holding stereotypes, especially about outgroups
- David Brooks: People are not "a puzzle that can be solved but a mystery that can never be gotten to the bottom of"

- Boundaries and Hierarchies
- CN is linked to social boundaries and hierarchies
- Not all hierarchies are bad
  - But many are rooted in culture, not Christianity
  - Tattoos on the Heart

- Fear and Power
- Christian nationalism is tied to fear and threat
- Fear and threat lead to the outcomes described above
